Set on 140 acres of natural beauty in Wheatley Heights, Long Island, NY. Usdan is a safe, welcoming place within which campers have the freedom to build new friendships, explore nature, develop personal independence, and have fun, alongside their art making.

POSITION SUMMARY

The Safety Monitors will be responsible for monitoring and escorting students on campus at Usdan Summer Camp for the Arts.

- Safety Monitors in an outdoor camp environment and are expected to communicate with students and other staff effectively.
- Safety Monitors will be friendly, outgoing, lovers of the arts, who are focused on growing and learning.
- Work enthusiastically with children, be flexible and be able to follow directions.
- Must be authentic, reliable, respectful, thoughtful, and organized.
- Safety Monitors will be self-starters as well as collaborators.
- Safety Monitors must have excellent communication skills and be able to communicate well with students, staff, peers, nurses and parents and react quickly in safety sensitive situations, while respecting confidentiality and privacy.
- Other duties as assigned.

The above job description is not intended to be an all-inclusive list of duties and standards of the position. Maintenance staff will be expected to follow any other instructions, and perform any other related duties, as assigned by their supervisor.



JOB REQUIREMENTS

QUALIFICATIONS

- Be 17 years of age as of July 1, 2024.
- Experience working with children.
- Must complete New York State required trainings, including but not limited to a Sexual Harassment Prevention training and a Child Abuse and Neglect/Maltreatment Identification. Links to required trainings will be provided after hiring.
- CPR training is not required but a plus.
- Have reliable transportation to Usdan's campus. Requests for accommodations are subject to approval by senior management.

2024 SUMMER SEASON DATES AND TIMES

COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS

\$3,510.00 Stipend, at least 25 hours per week in season

Complimentary use of studio space for their own artistic purposes, pre- and post-season, pending availability; semi-weekly use of swimming pool after camp hours; and occasional use of other facilities (e.g. tennis courts).

Workshops in subjects like yoga, ceramics, and archery with other faculty and staff, if offered.

Transportation:

- Additional opportunities to serve as a bus monitor, which consists of riding the bus to and from camp and supervising students. Faculty and staff will receive a stipend (\$400-\$700)

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

Usdan is a 140-acre campus with facilities spread throughout - distances vary and are along uneven surfaces, up and down hills. Some facilities are elevated and require one to two stairs to enter.

Although this position mostly consists of office work, there will be many opportunities for this position to traverse the campus, especially during the summer season. Some staff walk an average of two miles per day. Other physical demands include the ability to work in a hot, humid environment; the ability to speak clearly and understand the speech of another person; and the ability to prioritize sounds and focus on one sound among many.

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential physical functions of this position.
